Course Goals:

1. Develop a life long appreciation of music & the arts
2. Improve musical technique through ensemble & sectional rehearsal/performance
3. Develop interpretive skills as an ensemble
4. Develop teamwork & leadership skills
5. Become more proficient sight-readers
6. Apply a knowledge of music theory & history
7. Share your passion for music with the TPHP community

Expectations & Obligations:

1. Learn a demanding list of repertoire
2. PRACTICE- it's your homework!
3. 100% participation: being on time, asking questions, improving technique, listening to suggestions & helping others. Let's play the music, not just the notes!!!!
4. Demonstrate a knowledge & appreciation of basic music theory; you must know all your major & harmonic minor scales for warm-ups.
5. Be an active participant, always hold yourself to a high standard
6. Maintain a cooperative & collaborative attitude
7. Keep equipment in playable condition
8. Show respect to staff, artists & fellow students

Classroom Procedures

Instrument drop off- The classroom will be open by 7:15 each morning

Instrument pick up- The room will be open for at least 20 mins. after school, sometimes longer.

Music Storage- Each instrument has a designated area for storage. Name tag on case please!

Music Folders- After seating auditions you will receive a folder to keep at school with all your original pieces. Our music is quite expensive. You will be responsible for replacing lost or damaged music. Place your folder in the storage cabinet at the end of each rehearsal. Please only use pencil when marking your music & always keep a pencil in your folder. All students will receive practice copies of the music by logging on to the website.

Restroom- Take care of all personal needs before class begins.

Clean Up- Put your chair, music stand & folder away after each class. Percussion must be stored in the proper location. Class will not be dismissed until the room is cleaned properly.

Stay Current- Check my website in order to stay current with events throughout the year.

Letters of Recommendation- Please be sure to ask in advanced for summer camp & college letters. It is in your best interest that I have at least four weeks to write a fabulous letter for you. Visit your counselor for info. regarding requesting a letter.

Classroom Rules:

Food- Absolutely no food or drink allowed! Bottled water is ok. Violators will be assigned classroom beautification duties during lunch, break or after school.

School Equipment- IF IT'S NOT YOURS DON'T TOUCH IT! This will relieve you of any responsibility should anything disappear or become broken. All students using school owned instruments must fill out an instrument agreement form.

Outside Materials- Do not bring to your seat: homework, books, ipods, cell phones, rubics cubes or anything else you can think of that does not pertain to this class. Outside materials are only a distraction to you and those around you. If I see it, it's mine until the end of the day. Repeat offenders will receive a discipline referral.

Punctuality- You must be in the classroom when the tardy bell rings. Once the bell rings you have 3 mins. to be seated with your instrument & music folder ready. 5 tardies= discipline referral to your assigned Assistant Principal. It is not my responsibility to inform you that you have been marked tardy. If you are late, consider yourself marked tardy! If you are 30 mins. late you will be marked absent.

Rehearsal Activity- Pay attention! Many suggestions for improvement of others will also apply to you.

No Talking- Talking during rehearsal will result in an F for your daily participation grade.

Raise your hand- This is just like any other class, you must raise your hand if you have a question, comment or concern.

Posture- It is imperative that you sit in proper playing position at all times. Improper posture negatively affects your tone production.

Sickness- If you're sick PLEASE do not come to my class and spread your germs! If you come to school, you are expected to participate. If you are too ill to play your instrument I need a note from the doctor, otherwise you are expected to play.

Missed Work In Other Classes- Please do not ask me if you can make up missed work from other classes during my class.

Concerts- Everything we work on in class leads up to our concerts. If you have an emergency concert day your parent/guardian needs to notify me asap! If you miss a concert you will be required to play each piece so that I am able to assess your progress.

Extra Practice- You are more than welcome to use our practice rooms after school. Be sure to first check how long I plan on staying.

Grading

80% Daily Participation/Performances **20%** tests/quizzes/projects

Suggested Materials-

Metronome & Tuner- Important for successful at home practice

Lyre & Flip Folder- (band students) for Pep Band

Woodwinds- 4 extra reeds (nothing smaller than a size 3). Cl & Sax. players should all have a hard rubber mouthpiece (*see me for specific suggestions*)

Brass- Valve oil, cleaning supplies & mutes. Tpt. players should have a cup mute, plunger & a straight mute

Strings- Rosin & an extra set of strings.

Percussion- Stick bag including: snare sticks (wood tip), hard rubber mallets, medium yard mallets & timpani mallets, (*see me for specific suggestions*)

Concert Attire

Orchestra/Band-

Guys- Tuxedos (w/ a black bow tie), black socks (not ankle socks) & all black shoes

Ladies- All black. If you chose to wear a dress it must be at or below your knees.

Shoes must be all black

Jazz Band-

TP Jazz Band Shirt, black pants, black socks (not ankle socks) & Black shoes

Pep Band-

Black shirt/sweatshirt & jeans

Leadership *We will vote on leadership positions in each class

Class President- Represent class @ booster mtgs., help organize trips, fundraisers & competitions

Publicity- Help publicize concerts & music dept. events

Historian- Take pictures & coordinates video taping of concerts

Librarian- Help organize/maintain the music library & class folders
