

Ten Rules to Help Your Child Succeed

1. Maintain an open line of communication with your child.
2. Praise, encourage and affirm your child often.
3. Provide a healthy, safe, and supportive environment.
4. Decide with (not for) your child, a regular time and place to study.
5. Encourage your child(ren) to explain homework to another person.
6. Build in a reward/discipline system.
7. Monitor your child's progress both at home and in school.
8. Share experiences, dreams, and goals with your child.
9. Maintain contact with school personnel/administrators.
